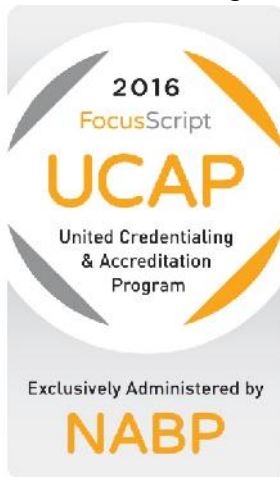


CONVERSIO HEALTH ANNOUNCES UCAP ACCREDITATION

Conversio Health is awarded accreditation by FocusScript United Credentialing and Accreditation Program (UCAP)

UCAP is a joint effort between the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) and FocusScript to enhance the process and standards of accreditation for compounding pharmacies. NABP is a nationally respected impartial professional organization whose key mission is focused on supporting state boards of pharmacy in protecting public health. FocusScript is an independent compound management company that applies proven techniques and tools through a certified network of credentialed and accredited providers to provide solutions to the marketplace that make quality compounding affordable and accessible.

Conversio Health met the rigorous standards as applied by UCAP including a review of business and quality practices, attestation of a code of conduct, and compounding specific requirements, using NABP's Verified Pharmacy Program (VPP) as its foundation. The VPP survey focuses on The U.S. Pharmacopeial Convention (USP) <797> requirements and standards. USP <797> provides standards for compounding sterile preparations to help ensure patients receive quality preparations that are free from contaminants and are consistent in intended identity, strength and potency. UCAP accreditation allows pharmacies to meet regulatory inspection requirements for non-resident licensure in several states, including Virginia and Texas.

Compounding is an integral part of Conversio Health's overall service delivery and contributes to significant outcomes, such as a 58% decrease in patient respiratory readmissions. Conversio Health has a California State Board of Pharmacy Sterile Compounding License, has consistently met compounding accreditation requirements from agencies such as the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) and the Joint Commission and is licensed to serve patients nationally. FocusScript created the comprehensive accreditation program in 2015. Conversio Health completed the UCAP survey and site inspection earning the right to display the compounding
